Travelling to and from Idre Fjäll

By air/train/bus/car

Stockholm Arlanda airport is about six hours' drive from Idre Fjäll. You can also travel by train from Stockholm Arlanda airport to Mora.

Starting from Oslo airport Gardermoen you reach Idre Fjäll in about four hours by car.

Mora domestic airport is the closest airport with daily connection from Stockholm Arlanda airport. From Mora you reach Idre Fjäll by car or bus in about two hours.

Parking

When you arrive to Idre Fjäll you will find media parking outside the Pernilla Wiberg Hotel and there will also be parking space reserved for media close to the competition area.
